

This list is adaptable for both very formal church ceremonies, or informal beach or garden, or home ceremonies. We will use the locale (beach, garden, park, etc.) to capture some unique photos of your wedding day.

Actual number of photographs and poses will be based on the size of your wedding party, the location of you wedding, the number of events, and the number of hours included in the package you book. Be sure to plan accordingly and book a package to cover your wedding from start to finish. The above list is a suggested guideline; all shots may not be possible due to circumstances beyond our control. All of the formal portraits can be taken before the ceremony if you wish, as not to delay arrival at your reception. Please let us know of anything special you would like so that we can plan accordingly.

To the Bride and Groom:

As your wedding photographer, we want your wedding day to be enjoyable and memorable. We realize there is a lot of activity that day, and in many cases, time is of the essence. In order to complete your photography in a timely manner, we must have your help.

Since we do not know the family members or the bridal party, we ask that you designate someone, perhaps a bridesmaid and/or groomsman, to make sure the key people remain nearby during the portrait sessions. Prior to the wedding you might want to inform the bridal party and family members of the photographic events that will take place before and after the ceremony.

We know you want special portraits of your wedding day, and we will do everything possible to make the process comfortable and stress-free for you. We are not a “cookie cutter” photographer—each bride has a unique personality and each wedding a unique style, which we want to capture for you. This may involve a few more minutes in front of the camera, and may require your bridal party to remain with the photographer for a little longer, but this is the one opportunity we have to capture your day in photographs, and the results will be worth it.

Our work depends in large part on the cooperation of all parties involved; and we appreciate your help and attention to this detail.

Included is a photography format and list of the traditional portraits. We are not limited to this list, it is a guideline only. Some photographs may not be suitable to your wedding—we always try to photograph the poses and style that suits you best.

You do not have to check off or provide a list of photos for us. However, at certain points during the formal photography session we will stop and ask you if there are any other photos you want that we haven’t done up to that point, so think about this and be prepared to let us know at that point.

Traditionally, the Bride and Groom are photographed separately prior to the ceremony. If you wish to do this differently, it is fine, just let us know. We can do all of the formal portraits before the ceremony, after the ceremony, or some before and some after, depending on your schedule and time frame for the reception.
